“Creating a Safe and Inclusive Campus Environment: Combating Ragging and Promoting Zero Tolerance Policies”.

Objective of the Programme:

The objectives of the Webinar on Anti-ragging include promoting a safe and respectful educational environment, raising awareness about the harmful effects of ragging, empowering students to speak up against ragging, and fostering a culture of zero-tolerance towards bullying and harassment.

Details: On 19th January 2021, Anti- ragging advisory committee of Hiralal Bhakat College in collaboration with IQAC successfully organized **A One-Day State Level Webinar on “Creating a Safe and Inclusive Campus Environment: Combating Ragging and Promoting Zero Tolerance Policies”** on virtual mode in an effort to promote a safe and welcoming environment for all students through google meet platform. The programme aimed at educating students about the harmful effects of ragging and to raise awareness about the consequences of engaging in such activities. The programme was started with the felicitation of our Honourable Resource person and guests. The programme was inaugurated with an inaugural song sung by one of our students of the department of English. Next, our Honourable TIC, Dr. Gautam Sen, gave the welcome speech. Prof. Sudipta singhathe, convenor, outlined its goal. This was followed by the keynote speech delivered by our eminent Resource Person. She highlighted the college's zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and emphasizing the importance of creating a conducive learning environment for all students and shared insights on the legal aspects of ragging, the psychological impact on victims, and the role of students in preventing ragging incidents.

A question-and-answer session was also managed to have been included in the programme. This allowed students to express their questions and concerns about ragging policies and processes. The attendees enthusiastically participated in talks, giving their viewpoints and promising to uphold dignity and compassion in their dealings with other pupils.

Outcome: Students as well as faculty members present at the programme got enriched with the worthy words and information delivered at the Resource Person's speech. The Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme on virtual mode of Hiralal Bhakat College was a huge step towards instilling a culture of respect, empathy, and mutual understanding among students. By increasing awareness and teaching students about the negative impacts of ragging, the curriculum demonstrated the college's commitment to the well-being and safety of all members of the academic community. This, therefore, would be expected to have been fruitful to make our institution as zero tolerance to ragging premises.
