Details:

The programme was started with the auspicious event of lightening of lamp and opening of the wall-magazine which was, then, followed by the felicitation of the Resource persons and guests. After the inauguration of the programme with an inaugural song sung by some of the students of Semester –VI, Dept. Of English, the welcome speech was delivered by the Principal. The seminar aimed to explore the themes of isolation, connection, and societal engagement in the works of Victorian writers. There was also a very interactive question- answer session at the end of the session.


